

## Natural monument “Slepikovskiy cape”

(Duration: 10-12 hours; one way travel time: 2.5 hours; distance: 143 km)

Slepikovskiy cape is located on the southwest coast of Sakhalin Island. It presents a unique ecosystem, the only sandy cape on Sakhalin. About 200 species of vascular plants are protected here (*Taxus cuspidata* Siebold & Zucc. ex Endl., *Quercus crispula* Blume, *Juniperus sargentii* (A. Henry) Takeda ex Koidz., *Juniperus conferta* Parl. and others). Also this cape is the only place, where you can meet Japanese tree frog (*Hyla japonica* Guenther) on Sakhalin.

In 1934, while the south part of Sakhalin Island belonged to Japan, new locals built a lighthouse and called it Notoro. This lighthouse, 27 meters high, still rises above dunes.

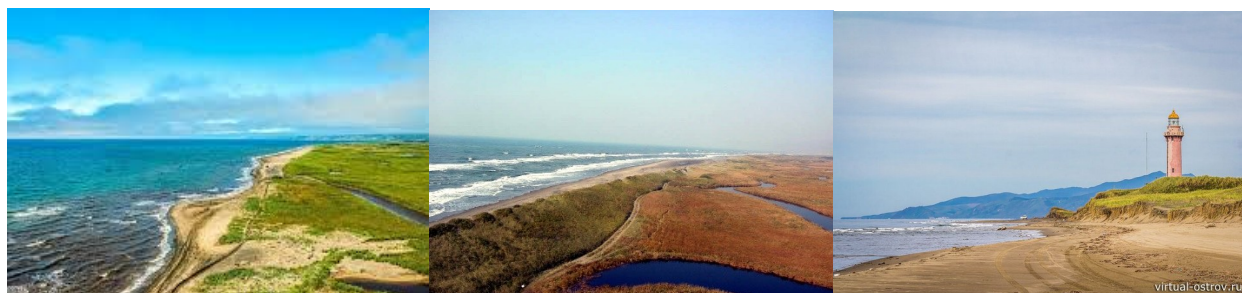
